## *Uniform* **REQUIREMENTS**

- All PCA students are required to wear a solid uniform polo in navy blue, light blue, white, or gold/yellow (no logo required).
- If you would like to add the school logo, this could be done through PCA. Please contact us to coordinate dropping off your child's polos.
- For the bottom, boys are to wear navy blue or khaki uniform flat front shorts or pants. Girls are to wear navy blue or khaki uniform scooter skorts, or flat front shorts or pants. Please make sure uniform bottoms are modest in fit and length. Traditional uniform bottoms can be found for purchase at Amazon, Old Navy, etc.
- 2K-5K girls may also wear navy blue, light blue, or gold/yellow uniform polo dresses.
- Students must wear closed toe sneakers daily. We ask for our youngest PCA students to wear sneakers that have a Velcro closure (no laces). Sneakers may be worn in any color. Socks must be worn in white, black, navy, or grey.
- Students may wear sweaters in solid navy blue, grey, or white ONLY (no wording or graphics printed on sweater will be permitted).
